What vaccines should I get?

Please note that these are the guidelines that The Bridge Clinic uses; some veterinarians follow different protocols.

When should

I get them?

Rabies

*required by PA State law

Distemper

*aka DHPP,
DAPP or DA2PP
 *Covers
 distemper,
 adenovirus,
 parvo,
parainfluenza

Leptosporosis

(recommended in certain
 areas/contexts)

Bordetella (aka Kennel cough; mostly for boarding, sometimes grooming)

Canine Influenza (mostly for boarding, sometimes grooming)

Lyme

(for certain contexts)

Rabies

*12 weeks or older, then annually

Distemper

*Every 3-4 weeks from 8-16 weeks, then annually

Spay & Neuter

When do I spay/neuter?

Small male/female:

at 3-6 months

Large male: 1 year

Large female: 6-12 months

Microchip: At time of spay/neuter

Bordetella: starting at 8 weeks
Lepto: starting at 8 weeks,
2 doses, 3 weeks apart

Influenza: starting at 8 weeks

Anything else?

Dewormer: 8 weeks (multiple doses)
Heartworm testing: at 6-9 months;
keep them on monthly preventative
before and after test
Flea and tick control: Monthly or
quarterly, depending on what

preventative is used

Core Vaccines:

What vaccines should I get?

Please note that these are the guidelines that The Bridge Clinic uses; some veterinarians follow different protocols.

When should I get them?

Rabies

*12 weeks or older *Then annually

Spay & Neuter

When do I spay or neuter?

Male: 3 months

Female: 3 months

Microchip: at time of spay/neuter

Rabies

*required by PA State law

Distemper

*aka FVRCP, HCP

*Covers "distemper" aka
panleukopenia, herpes,
calicivirus

FELV: Due to low demand, this is not a vaccine that The Bridge Clinic carries.

Distemper

*Every 3-4 weeks from 8-16 weeks *Then annually

Anything else?

Pewormer: 8 weeks (multiple doses)

FIV/FeLV Testing:

preferably test at 3 and 6 months

Flea and tick control: Monthly or

quarterly, depending on what is used.

Most contexts only require flea

treatment, unless cat is outdoor.
